AdvancePost, Inc. to Locate Presorting Facility in Macon, GA

Macon, GA - Ed Klaameyer, President of AdvancePost, Inc., joined local economic development officials today to announce that they will locate a U.S. Domestic Mail presorting facility in Macon, GA. AdvancePost, Inc. has leased a 42,140 sf facility in the Ocmulgee East Business Park on I-16. The facility will provide work for as many as 65 employees by the end of 2007, with expansion into a total of 80,890 sf of processing and warehouse space. The company expects to be operational in Macon by July 1st with rapid growth heading into Q4 of this year.

AdvancePost, Inc., headquartered in Tampa, Florida, provides business mailing service technology to corporate customers across the nation. Also, AdvancePost, Inc. is one of only a select few mail presort companies approved by the General Services Administration (GSA) to process mail for many of the Federal Government agencies.

Klaameyer said the company had explored options for a facility in the I-75 corridor between Atlanta and Macon, the surrounding area and even a site in Alabama. "From a transportation logistics point of view, it just made good economic sense to locate here. This strategic location will cut transport time for processed mail to major US Postal Service Business Mail Entry Units across the country." Klaameyer further states, "With the addition of a state-of-the-art parcel fulfillment operation here in Macon, we have expanded our growth opportunities and will enhance the mailing solutions we now offer our customers."

Steve Kruger, Chairman of the Macon Economic Development Commission, stated that, "AdvancePost represents another company who has taken advantage of Macon's ideal location to establish a distribution center to serve customers across the country." Kruger continues, "We have been promoting the area as a centralized location for companies looking to reach markets not only in the southeast but to the nation as well. AdvancePost will be a great addition to our growing family of logistics related companies."
